ORDER

Whereas, blatant land use and change in kind of soil has been taking place deliberately across the National highway i.e. Four lane by the owners in connivance with contractors of Four lanes resultantly defeating the objective of J&K Agrarian Reforms Act, 1976 and particularly contravene section 13 of J&K Agrarian Reforms Act, 1976;

Whereas, the existing land owners across the four lanes from Manthal, Mand up to Chenani are endeavouring to get the occasion to level their lands at such patches where they are uneven and below the level of Four lane;

Whereas, the ownership rights have been granted to various lands holders and they (land owners) are equally restricted to change the kind of soil for residential, commercial and other purposes by section 13 of the Jammu & Kashmir Agrarian Reforms Act, 1976; and

Whereas, an attempt to capture the violators and violations with regard to change in land use a regular squad (Commission) headed by Additional Deputy Commissioner Udhampur is constituted who shall monitor and submit the cases for action to this office;
