**Subject: Circular Instructions for the disposal of remand cases.**

Sir,

Kindly find enclosed a copy of circular No. 402/275-Governor main/1131-44 Dated 04-06-2016 where under it is reiterated that the disposal of remand cases remanded from time to time by the Appellate and Revisional Authorities should be done by the revenue officers within a period of 2 to 3 months. The act of delay on part of revenue officers whom the cases are remanded amounts to callousness vis-avis the public and procrastination and non-adherence to the directions of the higher authorities/ courts.

In this context, I am directed to circulate the circular instructions issued by worthy Divisional Commissioner, Jammu in this regard for its implementations/ compliance in letter and spirit also convey the progress on fortnightly basis.

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### CIRCULAR

It has generally been observed that the Revenue officers in the field to whom cases are remanded from time to time by the Appellate and Revisional Authorities for disposal after spot inquiry, verification vis-a-vis revenue records and hearing interested parties, as the case may be, take a lot of time deciding the same. Regrettably, the delay in certain cases is of decades. Consequently, justice is denied for long and the parties suffer very badly. This act of delay on the part of the Revenue officers amounts to callousness vis-a-vis the public and procrastination and non-adherence to the directions of the higher authorities/courts.

The objective of remanding a case is a thorough probe / investigation of the case as the same does not seem to have been done earlier as was required. Ordinarily such cases are required to be disposed of under due process of law in light of the remand orders within a reasonable time frame as may be necessary keeping the facts and nature of each case in view. However, the uncondonable delays that have been caused in certain cases is no way justified and is highly regrettable. It is, therefore, imperative that each remand case is paid the attention, due to it, by the officer/s to whom the cases are remanded and the case is taken to the logical conclusion at the earliest.

In view of the above, all the revenue officers in the field are enjoined to ensure that the cases which are remanded to them by the Appellate / Revisional or other Authorities / Courts are dealt with by them under due process of law keeping in

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view the directions contained in the remand orders and in presence of the parties and other concerned as the case may be with promptitude and decide the same generally within a period of 2 to 3 months. The said Revenue officers shall also maintain a separate Misalband Register in respect of all the remand cases which are presently pending with them or which may reach them in future to monitor their timely and day-to-day disposal in public interest.
