Subject:- Financial Assistance under the Rashtriya Arogya Nidhi (RAN).

Sir/Madam,

In a petition submitted to Prime Minister's Office by Shri Karar Hussain Siddiqui, President, Afrin Foundation, A/5, Opera Park Piraman Road, N.H. 8, G.I.D.C, Ankleshwar-393002, Gujarat regarding the treatment of cancer, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India vide No. Z-14011/51/2015-CR dated 13th July, 2015 has responded as under:-

1. The Government of India supplements the efforts of the States for prevention and control of Cancer. To build capacity up to district level, National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke (NPCDCS) was launched and has been brought under the umbrella of National Health Mission (NHM). The objectives of the programme include awareness generation, early diagnosis and referral of cancer patients to higher facilities in the country, under the Tertiary Care Cancer Centre Scheme, Government of India will assist in establishing 20 State Cancer Institute and 50 Tertiary Care Cancer Centres in different parts of the Country.
2. The treatment of cancer patients in various Government Hospitals is either free or subsidized both for the Central and State Government Hospitals. In addition to Cancer diagnosis and treatment by the State Government Health Institutes, the Central Government Institutions such as All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Safdurjung Hospital, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, PGIMER Chandigarh, JPIMER Puducherry, Chittranjan National Cancer Institute, Kolkata etc. provide facilities for diagnosing and treatment of Cancer.
3. Besides the above, financial assistance to Below Poverty Line (BPL) patients is available under the Rashtriya Arogya Nidhi (RAN). Along with this, the Health Minister's Cancer Patient Fund (HMCPF) with the RAN has been set up in 2009 wherein 27 erstwhile Regional Cancer Centres (RCCs) are provided with revolving funds to provide immediate financial assistance upto Rs. 2,00,000/- to BPL cancer patients.
