Sub:- Regulation of Cyber Café/Computer training Centers.

Where, Apart from other areas. District Udhampur has also suffered a lot due to militancy. The Anti- National elements – militants and OGWs are using new technology for communication/spread of hatred / terror.

Whereas, thought there is declining in militancy, still any un- towards incidents can not be over ruled and prevention as for as possible is needed to be taken.

Whereas, information Technology – Cyber Cafes are being used by such group for spread of terror message and communication among their group.

Whereas, the Govt. of India and state Govt. in information Technology Department has issued certain guidelines for regulation of Cyber Café/ Computer Training centers.

Therefore, on the analogy of Draft guidelines, I, Pandurang K. Pole (IAS) District Magistrate Udhampur duly vested with powers U/S 144 of Criminal Procedure Code, do hereby order that:-

1. Cyber Café owners/network service provider who provides the computer service including internet access to general public in any of its form, either on payment or free of charge for any purpose including recreation or amusement, shall register his Cyber Café / network service in this office by or before 20 Jan, 2012 after fulfilling the Formalities.
2. The Cyber Café/ Computer Centre shall ensure proper identification of users before allowing him/her to use its computer resources. For the purpose of identification to the satisfaction of Cyber Café owner/ operator, he may produce Identity card issued By school/college or Photo Identity card/Debit Card or Passport or Voter Identity card issued by employee/government agency or Driving License etc. The Cyber Café owner shall keep record of user identification document either in photocopy or in scanned copy format such record to be maintained for the period of at least one year.
3. The user shall register his/her particulars in a log Register to be maintained by Cyber Café owner/operator in the format to be given by DIO (NIC). Monthly report of the log register showing data wise detail of user shall be e-mailed to DIO (NIC) by the 5th day of next month on e-mail ID to be given by the DIO.
4. Proper maintenance and safety of log register and identification documents shall be ensure by the Cyber Café owner/operator.



5. Cyber Café owner/operator Shall ensure adherence to the provision of information Technology Act 2000 including with respect access to the websites relating to child pornography or obscene information.

Registering authority i.e. District Magistrates along with Technical officer DIO (NIC) and concern station House Officer may inspect Cyber Café/Computer training centers for ensuing compliance to the above directions.
